Election for Assistant to the General Secretary (Conduct)

As you will be aware Jim Foy retired from the police service and the Joint Central Committee, as a consequence of ill health on the 29th June.

Jim's retirement now triggers the requirement for an election for his successor.

Elections for Assistants to the General Secretary are covered by Rule 10 of the Police Federation (Scotland) Rules 2013. Rule 10.2.1 states;

A member seeking election as an Assistant to the General Secretary as mentioned in Rule 10.1 shall intimate in writing his or her intention to stand for election to the General Secretary and shall give not less than 28 days' notice. For the purpose of this Rule 'in writing' shall include by facsimile or electronic mail.

The next meeting of the Joint Central Committee shall be on the 22nd and 23rd August 2017 and the election will be amongst the first items of business.

Accordingly, I will require any nominations by **close of business day (1700 hours) on Monday 24th July 2017.**
