Scottish Police Federation – Representative Elections for Vacancies – Information

I refer to the above and write to advise of the call for nominations for representatives for the numbers and ranks specified in the following electoral constituencies;

North Area

A/B Division = 1 x Insp ranks
D Division = 1 x Cons

East Area Committee

P Division = 2 x Insp
C Division = 1 x Insp + 1 x Sgt
E Division = 2 x Insp ranks
J Division = 1 x Sgt

West Area

Argyll & West Dumbarton = 2 x Insp + 1 x Constable
Ayrshire = 2 x Insp + 1 Constable
Dumfries & Galloway = 2 x Insp
Greater Glasgow = 3 x Insp + 1 x Constable
Lanarkshire = 2 x Insp
OSD & Roads Policing = 1 x Insp
Renfrewshire & Inverclyde = 1 x Sgt + 1 x Cons
Crime = 1 x Insp + 1 x Sgt + 1 x Cons

A nomination period of 3 working weeks from 0900 on Friday 8th January to 1700 on Friday 29th January 2016 will apply. Nominations received out with this period will not be accepted. Candidates must be from and nominated and seconded by officers of the same rank and within the electoral constituency for which the vacancy exists.

All nominations must be emailed to david.ross@spf.org.uk No other form of nomination is acceptable. Nominations must include the details (including email contact details for verification purposes) of the candidate(s) and of the proposer(s) and seconder(s).

In the event no candidate is forthcoming from within the electoral constituency, a candidate of the appropriate rank may stand provided (s)he is nominated and seconded by officers of the same rank from WITHIN the electoral constituency. Such nominations must be received

within the nomination period and will only become valid in the event that the first condition laid out in the paragraph is met.

Non-subscribing members may **not** stand for election, nor nominate or second any candidate.

In the event that the number of nominations does not exceed the number of vacancies at the close of the nomination period, the candidate(s) will immediately be appointed as a representative.

Where the number of candidates exceeds the number of vacancies, any election(s) will take place at a time and in a manner determined by the General Secretary.
