Election of Health & Safety Secretary / Assistant to the General Secretary

I refer to the above and write to advise you that I have been advised by Peter Jones, SPF H&S Secretary of his intention to retire from the police service and the Joint Central Committee in 2017.

Peter's notified intention to retire now triggers the requirement for an election for his successor.

Elections for Officers of the Joint Central Committee are covered by Rule 10 of the Police Federation (Scotland) Rules 2013. Rule 10.2.1 states;

A member seeking election as an Officer as mentioned in Rule 10.1 shall intimate in writing his or her intention to stand for election to the General Secretary and shall give not less than 28 days' notice. For the purpose of this Rule 'in writing' shall include by facsimile or electronic mail.

The next meeting of the Joint Central Committee shall be on the 9th and 10th May 2017 and the election will be amongst the first items of business.

Due to Peter Jones only being able to formally confirm his retirement date at relatively short notice, the commitments from Conference and other recent significant events, the Chair has agreed she will accept nominations in this instance up to 21 days before the meeting.

Accordingly, I will require any nominations by close of business day (1700 hours) on Monday 17 April 2017.
