Police Pay - Information

I refer to the above and enclose for your information details of the police pay increase for 2014.

You will note the increase is for 1% across all pay points and all ranks.

You will also note that CRTP has increased by 1%.

Whilst it is recognised this increase is meagre and lower than inflation, this is a considerable achievement at a time when wider public sector pay continues to be squeezed and police pay elsewhere in the UK is reducing.

Police officers in Scotland are now the highest paid in the UK and see CRTP increasing while it reduces in England & Wales and remains static in Northern Ireland.
